Dear Parents/Carers,

This week, we have been revisiting place value in maths. The children have ordered numbers, explored reasoning questions and roman numerals. In English, the children have written a character description about a chosen character. In PE, the children have been introduced to our dance topic - The Haka. They have learnt what a haka is, why it is and was performed and started to look at the choreography. In topic, we have begun to explore our history topic - The Victorians. The children have created a timeline of events that happened during the Victoria era. In computing, the children have begun their unit on physical coding. They have coded a controllable device called a crumble. They coded it so it would make a flashing light and were all challenged to make the light flash by itself for longer and change colours. In Science the children have learnt about the life cycles of different animals.

Maths - We will be looking at rounding and powers of 10.

English - The children will be writing a character description. They then will be looking at different features of grammar.
