This week, the children have written a description about a giant in English. They have explored how to add suspense and written noun phrases in the style of Roald Dahl. In Maths, the children have worked on rounding numbers. In Science, the children have learnt about the different parts of a plant and how seeds are dispersed. In computing, the children have continued on their 'crumble' coding and have added code to make a motor spin. In art, they have explored the use of colour patterns in pop art and made informed decisions about their colour choices.
