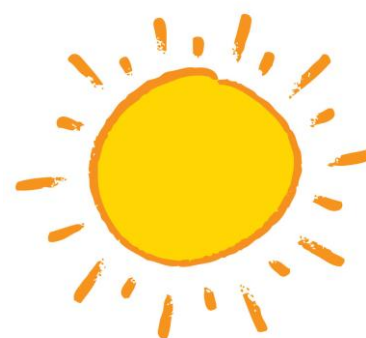


Year 4 Newsletter - 26.06.26
