English	
Reading: Group and individual reading which includes sounding out unknown words, recognising High Frequency and common exception words, developing fluency and comprehension. Spelling: High frequency and common exception words. Phonics: Level 5 (previously known as phase 5), recapping all taught graphemes and blending them together to read words. Handwriting: Capital letters, finger spaces, lower- and upper-case letters that sit appropriately on the lines with the correct sizing and spacing. Grammar: Sentence construction and punctuation – full stops, capital letters, commas questions marks and exclamation marks. Nouns, conjunctions, adverbs and adjectives. Writing composition: story writing including predictions and own versions, poetry, non-fiction writing.	
Maths	
Oral and mental maths – counting, mental strategies: Number bonds to 20, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, 10 more than a given number and doubles. Fractions: Halving and quarters of amounts and shapes. Measuring: Capacity, weight and mass, length Time: Learning to tell the time. o'clock, half past, before and after a given time. Shape: Names of 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

Plants Labelling a plant, identifying and naming plants, looking at changes in plants during the different seasons. Growing and caring for a plant. Materials Identifying different materials around in school, knowing what objects are made from, sorting and grouping objects by their material.
