Press the 'Hand in' button to hand in work once you have finished.

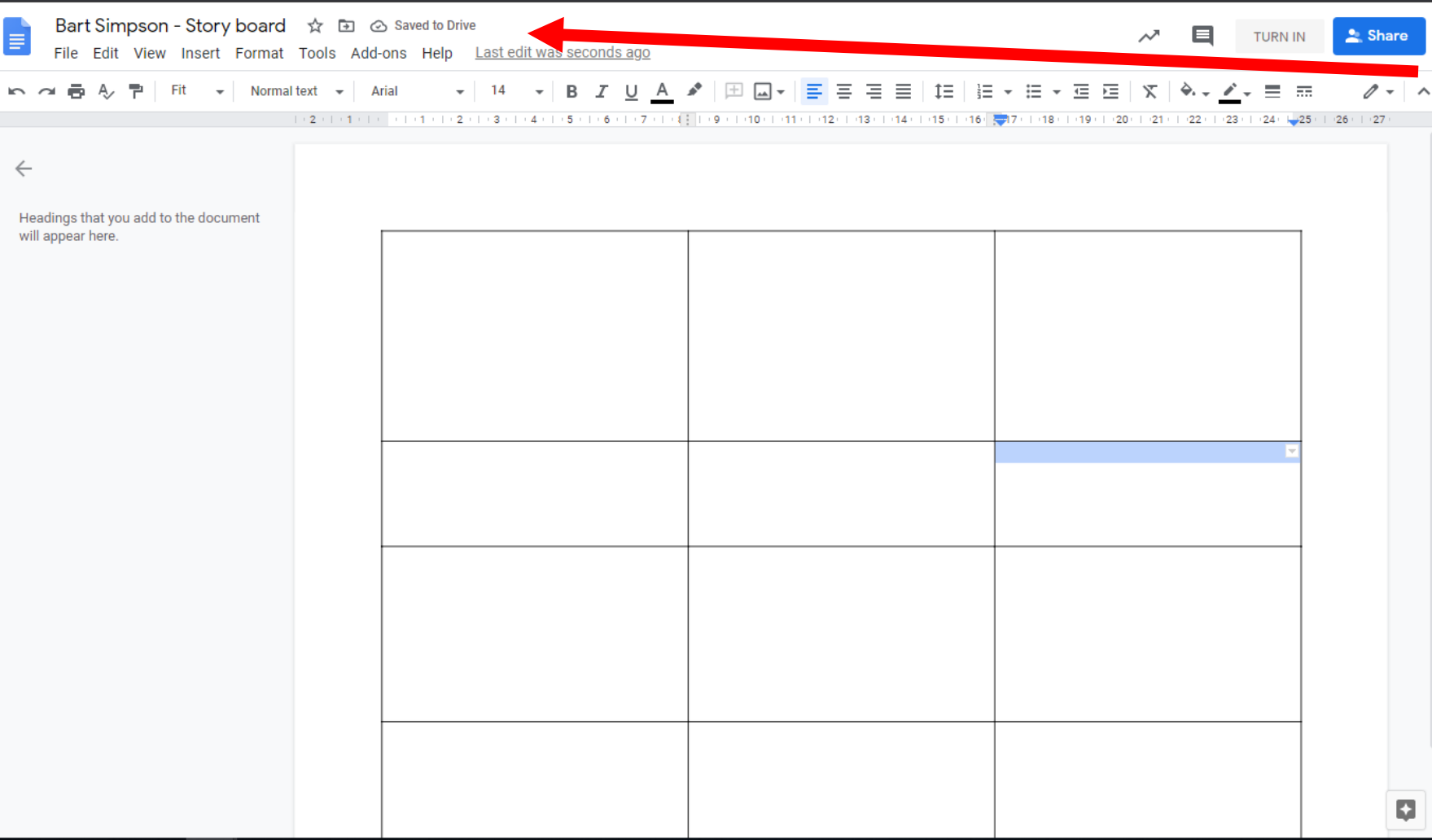
