Medical / Other appointments and Messages

Medication and Toilet Visits

Please ensure you have sent in any medication your child may need with clear instructions on dosage etc. Medication should be handed over from an adult to a staff member with a signed letter authorising the school to administer it. All children have a morning break and Reception and KS1 have afternoon breaks plus lunchtime. We want to minimise learning disruption and also children walking around school unsupervised so I have said to staff that children need to be encouraged to wait until break times to visit the toilet. If your child has a specific toilet need please let your child's class teacher know. Please discuss this with your child and thank you for your support in advance.
